Overview

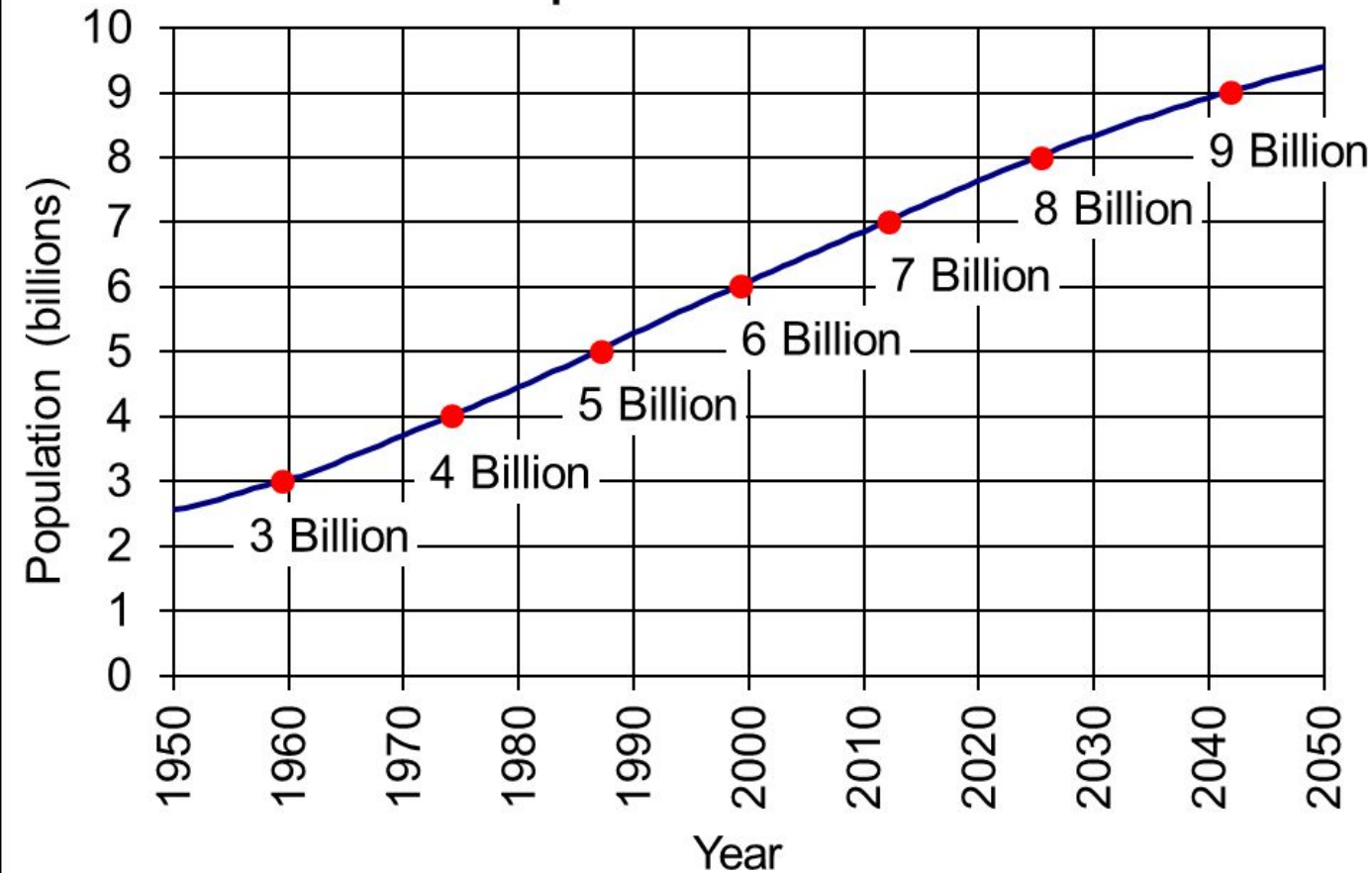
The United States Census Bureau has estimated the population of the world is 7.3 billion. We passed the 7 billion mark in 2012. According to papers that were published by the Bureau we passed 6.5 billion in 2006. Because of many different sources saying the numbers of the population over the last 30 years the number is basically unknown as to how many people are on Earth.

Researcher Carl Haub has calculated that there are over 100 billion people.

Future Growth and Decline

We estimate that by 2040 there will be somewhere around 9 billion people. In the last 50 years the growth rate has increased rapidly. In 2055 the population will most likely surpass 10 billion. We believe that the population will stop growing being the 21st century ends and that we will reach our peak which we will then decline because of health and economic reasons.
